## In NJ- LSRP Time is Here; RT is Ready!

**Next week, new contaminant releases in NJ will be referred to Licensed Site Remediation Professionals to investigate and remediate.**

Please contact us with any questions at the email address or phone number listed below.

**Those responsible for causing the release are responsible for hiring an LSRP and new Site remediation rules will be out next week.**

**Those responsible for existing release cases have three years to engage an LSRP. Such cases can remain under NJDEP oversight until then. Most of RT's clients are taking a "wait and see" approach until the rules come out and the options are more clear.**

**For those who want to move into an LSRP lead cleanup, RT is ready, with over a decade of experience at Massachusetts and Connecticut LSP/LEP sites, we know the ropes of privatized cleanup approaches. One Team member currently has temporary LSRP status, and two more are expected in the near future.**
